- Courses coded in **blue** are required for all M.Div. programs (58 hours).
- Courses coded in **green** are required for at least one M.Div. program and can generally be counted as electives in other programs (12 hours).
- **CIV** = courses taught via Compressed Interactive Video. **CIV-L** originates in Louisville; **CIV-DC** originates in Washington; **CIV-N** originates in Northborough (Boston)
- An average of nine hours per semester on site = 7-8 semesters (3.5 – 4 years, depending on remedial work) to complete the rotation. This will be equivalent to 70 hours credit, including 2 hours for Applied Ministry at some point (note that 40010 Personal Spiritual Disciplines is a prerequisite to Applied Ministry). Since Elementary Greek (0 hours), and Elementary Hebrew (0 hours), must be taken online, it is recommended that either Hebrew Syntax (3 hours), or Greek Syntax (3 hours) be taken online as a follow-up to the elementary course. These 7-8 semesters will put the student within 18 hours of graduation. The on-campus requirement of 18 hours can be satisfied with 6 J-term courses or with residency or a combination. Additionally, up to 30 hours may be earned online, but will not count toward the on-campus requirement.
- Extension center students may satisfy any of these requirements and potentially shorten their academic career with additional hours on campus or with supplementary courses online. Many of these same core courses are available online. J-term offerings will include some core courses as well as school-specific electives beyond the 58-hour M.Div. core.
