REGISTRATION CLOSES ON **MARCH 5.**

1. You may attend up to five different one-hour seminars. Your payment must accompany your registration form or we cannot process it.
2. If you wish to receive an SWI elective credit:
  - a) Register on e-Campus for SWI Seminar Saturday.
  - b) Attend 5 seminars and request recordings for an additional 3 seminars.
  - c) You will be given a list of suggested texts when you attend the seminars. You must choose one to purchase and read from any of the seminars that you attend. This should be one not previously read.
  - d) Submit a 2-3 page book review and 1 page summary for each of the 8 seminars of your choosing detailing what you learned. These will be due on **April 5**. The assignments can be e-mailed to [swi@sbts.edu](mailto:swi@sbts.edu); dropped off at Norton 105 during SWI classes or placed under the door of the SWI office in Norton 121.
3. Checks should be made payable to Southern Seminary with "SWI Seminar Saturday" on the memo. If you do not turn the form and payment in during class, you may mail both to **SWI, Box 244, 2825 Lexington Road, Louisville, KY 40280** or **place them under the door of the SWI office in Norton 121. Please do not send cash.**

(Note: This method of payment is an exception due to the nature of the conference, food costs, etc. For all other SWI classes, please continue to send payment directly to Accounting Services.)
4. You are welcome to attend without seeking credit. The cost will be the same whether you are able to stay all day or attend just one seminar.
5. You may invite neighbors, church members, etc. to attend with you, however, all attendees must complete and return the attached form. Do not register on e-Campus unless you are taking the course for credit.
6. We regret that childcare will not be available.
7. You will receive a confirmation in class by March 1 with details about the schedule and seminar locations. If you are not in a class, you will receive an e-mail confirmation.
8. Space is very limited! Registrations will be processed in the order received so be sure to turn in the attached form as soon as possible.
9. Information for ordering recordings of seminars will be given when you arrive.
10. Recordings will be available for purchase but will also be available on loan to SWI students who are taking the course for credit.
