JOB SUMMARY:

The Rotisserie Station Attendant has the duty of prepping and cooking the items served at the rotisserie station. Some items would include whole chickens, specialty salads, baked potatoes, and more. The Rotisserie Station Attendant also has the function of assisting at other stations if needed.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

The employee in this position will have the following essential job functions:

- Excellent communication skills
- Manage supplies and ensure orderly work areas
- Attend to customer needs during meal times
- Greet guests upon arrival
- Display great customer service skills
- Professional appearance required
- Able to bend, kneel, squat, stand and lift heavy objects as needed (up to 50 pounds)
- Mandatory five-day work week, 3:00 pm-8:30 pm

Performs other duties as may be assigned by supervisor.
